Meeting minutes

Approval of Minutes of July meeting: Lettie moved, Heidi seconded, motion passed.

Communications:

- It has been a good start to summer. Of 300 children's summer reading kits, 298 have been distributed.
- Full hours of operation are expected in September.
- Financial Report: on-track. This year's travel budget will likely go unspent.

Unfinished Business:

- Approval of bills: Cindy moved, Carol seconded, motion passed.
- Approval of weeds, discards: Heidi moved, Maria seconded, motion passed.

New Business:

- September is Library Card Sign-up Month. BPL will be promoting this with the B-E schools. Those who sign up will be eligible for a drawing for prizes, including an I-Pad.
- Implications of new law enforcement legislation: Police will schedule training in changes for library staff. Since so much of the help needed is welfare checks, other agencies may become involved, including Compass Health, Community Action, and possibly EMTs. None of these changes are in place as of yet.
