

Burlington Parks & Recreation Scholarship Assistance Application

Scholarships are available for participants in many of Burlington Parks & Recreation's programs. Scholarship awards are intended to assist program participants who find themselves in circumstances of limited income. A participant's eligibility is based on several factors, including the program of interest.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Recreation Classes & Camps

- Participants must reside within the Burlington-Edison School District.
- Applications must be received at least 14-days prior to the start of the class or camp.
- Proof of eligibility must be submitted with your application. Copy of your child's free or reduced lunch letter, DSHS food assistance letter or detailed letter of explanation are examples of accepted forms of eligibility proof.
- Participants meeting the eligibility guidelines may be awarded up to \$100 in scholarship assistance per QUARTER.
- Participants will be required to contribute a nominal amount towards the program registration fee at the time of registration.
- Scholarships are not available for programs offered by organizations that contract with Burlington Parks & Recreation for use of its facilities. (Two examples would be the Skyhawks and Challenger Sports programs.)

B-E Youth Soccer Program

- Applications must be received by June 30.
- Proof of eligibility must be submitted with your application. Copy of your child's free or reduced lunch letter, DSHS food assistance letter or detailed letter of explanation are examples of accepted forms of eligibility proof.
- Participants meeting the eligibility guidelines may be awarded up to 100% of their registration fee in scholarship assistance.
- When a partial scholarship is awarded, participants will be required to pay their contribution towards the registration fee at the time of registration confirmation.

Registration for youth soccer is open May 1st through June 30th each year.

Scholarship funding is provided through the Burlington Parks & Recreation Department. Scholarships are made possible with thanks to private donations made by the community. Scholarship funds are limited and for that reason are awarded on a first come, first served basis to eligible participants.
