## Your Voice, Your Vision, Your Burlington

### Community Survey Summary

The “Your Voice, Your Vision, Your Burlington” community survey was fielded from October 19th, 2024 through November 24th, 2024. The survey collected feedback from the community to further understand their priorities to assist the City of Burlington in identifying areas of focus for the near future. The survey was available in English and Spanish and online and in print (see Appendix A for the surveys). The survey was promoted through several channels including:

- Project [webpage](#)
- Social media posts on the Burlington Parks and Recreation and Library Facebook pages
- Email listservs and e-newsletters
- A postcard mailer
- Flyers posted in local businesses
- The Town Hall kickoff event and six pop-up events around the city

There were a total of 263 surveys, 153 completed online (9 in Spanish) and 110 completed on paper (32 in Spanish). See Appendix B for all survey results.

## Survey Respondent Profile




Figure 1. How respondents are connected to Burlington

To better understand who responded to the survey, respondents were asked to select all that applied to them regarding their connection to Burlington (*Figure 1*). The options included whether they live (68%), visit (38%), work (30%), or own/operate a business in the City (8%).




Figure 2. Age group distribution of respondents

Survey participants were asked to share their age (Figure 2). The majority of respondents were between the ages of 30 and 64 (69%), which is greater than the percentage of people between the ages of 30 and 64 in the Burlington population<sup>1</sup> (45%).




Figure 3. How long respondents have lived in Burlington

Participants were then asked to indicate how long they have lived in Burlington (Figure 3). A majority of respondents, 41%, have lived in Burlington between 6 and 20 years, while a third have lived in Burlington for more than 20 years.

# Key Themes and Highlights




Figure 4. What respondents appreciate most about Burlington

Over half of respondents most appreciated Burlington's family-friendly atmosphere, closely followed by community events and the city's central 'hub' location. Outdoor activities and local shopping each received over 40% of responses. Respondents also commented that parks and recreation, the library, and Burlington’s small-town feel were elements they appreciated about Burlington. Respondents ranked overall Burlington services and facilities on a scale of 1 (poor) to 5 (excellent) with an average score of 3.

Respondents were asked how they would rate the overall quality of Burlington transportation, parks and recreation, police, fire, and library on a scale of 1 (lacks some things I need) to 5 (has everything I need) (Table 1). Individual service areas had an average rating between 3 and 4.

Survey participants were asked to provide open feedback on the different improvements to City services they feel would have the greatest overall benefit to the community. Some of the highlighted feedback included:

➤ **Improvements to parks and recreational facilities**

*“I would like to see Maiben Park improved – newer and bigger playground that is spread out so that kids have more room to run and play.”*

*“...healthy, fun activity for all ages – pickleball, basketball, walking and bike paths”*

*“More pet/teen/disability friendly parks/events/resources – more things to do around the city..”*

➤ **Enhanced transportation and road improvements**

*“I would like Burlington to become a more walkable/bikeable city – better walkability and bike ability around schools, public gatherings, and connectivity with public transportation”*

*“Street improvements, sidewalks for wheelchairs – in the older residential sections of town.”*

*“...rapid increase in traffic – I am concerned about the impact on traffic.”*

➤ **Improve community engagement and communication**

*“More in person events and community connections – I wish there were more big events like the fall festival”*

*“More advertising of things already happening – sometimes the community doesn’t know what’s going on”*

*“Connect with youth and hopefully get them more involved in the community”*

➤ **Address public safety concerns and housing**

*“Enforcing traffic laws in the bypass area – keeping the streets clean and safe for people and kids to walk”*

*“More streetlights – streets are too dark to see”*

*“Safe and affordable housing – adding high density housing without making appropriate improvements to infrastructure”*

*“Skills jobs housing SUD treatment options for homeless – homeless issues and drug issue enforcement so I can feel safe walking”*

➤ **Invest in library services and cultural spaces**

*“Art and cultural center in the Carnegie library”*

*“Do not live in the city limits but would appreciate being able to access the library services.”*

*“Extended library hours – library hours should be expanded to include Sundays”*

## Transportation




Figure 5. Typical modes of transportation among survey respondents

Overall, respondents rated transportation services in Burlington a 3 (on a scale of 1 (poor) to 5 (excellent)). Respondents were asked to indicate their typical mode of transportation (*Figure 5*). A majority, 95%, identified driving as their main mode of transportation, followed by walking (31%) and biking at 13%. Only 5% of respondents indicated using a bus and several individuals added comments about enhancing biking with safer and more accessible routes.

*“I would like to bike – shoulders too narrow, making it unsafe.”*

*“Would bike more if safer”*




Figure 6. How important transportation elements are to respondents

Respondents rated how important certain transportation elements were to them on a scale from “not very important” to “very important” (*Figure 6*).

- **Available downtown parking** was most important to respondents with 92% indicating it as either “somewhat” or “very important.” It had a weighted score of 3.70.
- **Available residential street parking** was the next most important with 77% selecting “somewhat” or “very important.” It had a weighted score of 3.14.
- **Adding more bike lanes** had mixed importance, with 30% rating it as “not very important” and 70% as “somewhat” or “very important.” It had a weighted score of 2.83.
- **More public transit routes/stops** had the lowest weighted average score (2.79) but still garnered over 73% rating it as “somewhat” or “very important.”

## Parks and Recreation




Figure 7. What parks and reaction services respondents use most

Overall, respondents rated parks and recreation services in Burlington a 4 on a scale of 1 (poor) to 5 (excellent). When asked about the different categories of services offered by parks and recreation, survey participants checked what they used the most in their daily lives (*Figure 7*). Respondents used parks the most, with 76% selecting this option. Playfields, the Skagit River Sports Complex, and kid’s programs/events followed with between 35%-42% of respondents selecting these options. The adult programs/events and Burlington Senior Center were close to 20%. Fewer than 15% of respondents selected the Burlington Community Center and teen programs/events (parks and recreation does not currently offer teen programs, but the library does). The “Other” category received close to 30 responses who provided other areas of use such as community events, dog parks, and camps.

*“...summer concerts at park! – special events”*

*“Specifically, the new dog park. It is awesome”*

*“...more summer camps for children – more classes”*




Figure 8. How important parks and recreation facilities are to respondents

Respondents rated the importance across various facilities generally associated with parks and recreation on a scale from “not very important” to “very important” (Figure 8).

- **More trails** received the most favorability with over 89% indicating as either “somewhat” or “very important.” It had a weighted score of 2.42.
- **Public swimming pool** followed with around a total of 80% as “somewhat” or “very important” and nearly half of that share was “very important.” It had a weighted score of 2.27.
- **New/updated community center** and **more sports courts** both had a similar importance rating, with 18% as “not important” and 80% as “somewhat” and “very important.” They had weighted scores of 2.25 and 2.23, respectively.
- **Pickleball courts** were of mixed importance, where 41% of respondents felt they were “somewhat important,” 34% felt they were “not important,” and 25% felt they were “very important.” It had a weighted score of 1.92.
- **Ice rink** had the lowest weighted score of 1.83 and the highest section for “not important,” 45%.

## Police and Fire

Overall, respondents rated police and fire services in Burlington each a 4 on a scale of 1 (poor) to 5 (excellent). Respondents were also asked which additional services or facilities they would like police and fire to offer. The main themes of the feedback participants provided included:

### ➤ Increased communication among outreach and community engagement

*“Proactive outreach – education in schools – I would like them to visit all the schools”*

*“More information on resources – medication disposal sites, smoke alarm/blood pressure checks, car seat information, etc.”*

*“Fire safety talks and resource support to students”*

➤ **More Spanish-speaking staff and bi-lingual engagement with the community**

*“Hire more Spanish-speaking police officers”*

*“DIVERSITY!!! – incorporate and have access to all families especially our Latinx population.”*

*“More contact (interaction/engagement) with Hispanics – Latino community liaison”*

➤ **Enhanced traffic safety enforcement**

*“Staff up to include more traffic enforcement”*

*“...police traffic, especially on Burlington Blvd.”*

*“Traffic through Burlington has increased immensely – we need more support in enforcing traffic safety”*

➤ **Facilitated CPR/First aid training and programs**

*“First Aid/CPR Self Defense Classes”*

*“I would love it if there was a free CPR class for all ages”*

*“Courses on 1<sup>st</sup> aid and CPR regularly – ID protection...”*

## **Library**




Figure 9. Library programs and services used most by respondents

Overall, respondents rated library services in Burlington a 4 on a scale of 1 (poor) to 5 (excellent). Survey participants were asked to identify the programs and services of the library they used most. *Figure 9* shows the results with book rentals being the most used service at 52%, followed by community events at 46%. The rest of the services ranged from 20-30% in use by respondents. About 15% of respondents indicated “Other”, offering additional feedback on children’s and teens programs, access challenges for county residents, and community and meeting spaces as the top three main themes.

*“The children’s programs are fantastic – teen and kid’s programs like Wednesday of Wonder and the Ice Cream Social.”*

*“Not available to county residents – city limits prohibit my access to the library.”*

*“Community rooms for meetings – gorgeous library with excellent free public meeting rooms!”*




Figure 10. How important library functions are to respondents

Respondents rated the importance of three programs and services on a scale from “not very important” to “very important” (Figure 10).

- **More programs/events** received the most favorability with over 86% of respondents indicating this either “somewhat” or “very important.” It had a weighted score of 2.30.
- **Better online resources** followed with around 81% of respondents indicating these as important and 47% of that share was “somewhat important.” It has a weighted score of 2.15.

- **Extended hours** had a similar importance rating, with 18% of respondents selecting “not very important” and 80% as “somewhat” or “very important.” It had a weighted score of 2.04.

## Summary

The survey participants had an overall appreciation and positive rating score for the different service areas in Burlington.

- Improvement suggestions for the city services included:
  - **Transportation:** Respondents suggested that the city focus on improving road safety and repair, adding bike lanes, and making the city more walkable/bikeable, particularly in older neighborhoods and certain parts of the downtown area.
  - **Parks and Recreation:** Expanding parks, creating pet/teen/disability-friendly spaces, and adding facilities like a new or updated community center and walking/biking paths.
  - **Police and Fire:** Key areas for improvement included community engagement, bi-lingual staff, traffic enforcement, and offering CPR/First Aid training. Respondents also emphasized focus for youth and engagement in schools.
  - **Library:** Survey participants expressed positive feedback to current programs and services and desired increased programs towards all ages in the community. Library accessibility to residents outside of city limits was a concern mentioned several times.
- More community engagement across several services including police and fire, libraries, and parks and recreation were emphasized to include more events, youth, and increased advertising of existing initiatives.
- Improving public safety, particularly with traffic enforcement, poorly lit streets, and maintaining police presence was a common concern among participants.
- Increasing accessibility and language access across multiple services and culturally relevant engagement, translation, and outreach among all services.

## Next Steps

The project team will use findings from this survey, along with feedback from community leader interviews, in-person events, focus groups, and another community-wide survey, to

summarize key themes and takeaways to include in future City planning efforts, such as the Comprehensive Plan update in 2025.





## Q18 What is your age group?


